Sri Lankan veggies in pots? ... WHY NOT!

I was asked recently by a Sri Lankan friend of mine whether the Sri Lankan type vegetables could be grown in pots. He has just moved into his newly built house which,



as yet, has no garden to speak of. The ground around his new house, he says, is a mix of hardpan clay and shale. It will take an enormous amount of top soil to be brought in to get a decent garden going, he carried on – but, in the meantime he was wondering whether he could grow a few veggies in pots.

The simple answer is ... yes, of course. One can grow virtually anything in pots.

The first and most important factor to consider is the potting mix. There are so many mixes available that one is in a quandary as to which one to choose. In general terms and without going into detail, maybe just keep in mind that 'cheap things no good'. You will get what you pay for. Most potting mixes are sold without fertilizers added to them. It is good practice to mix in some fertilizer, and dolomite, with your potting mix before filling the pots. Most nurseries do that, by the way. I also mix in some compost, for this assists in many ways ... but particularly in the ability of the mix to retain moisture for a longer period of time. I now also mix in a fairly new product called 'hydrocell' ... something that looks like broken up styrofoam. Read about it yourself by punching in 'hydrocell' on the internet. This too assists in the mix retaining moisture for a greater length of time.

The type and size of pot is important, and is dependant on what you are growing. Avoid using clay or terracotta pots as the sides of these pots absorb moisture which then

readily evaporates. The result is that your potting mix dries up much faster than if it is a plastic pot. The size of pot is relevant to what you are growing, as some plants have smaller root systems than others. Also, some plants require more water than others ... and the larger the pot the greater the water holding capacity. A trick you could try is to stand your pots in 'saucers' ... BUT, <u>large</u> saucers. Use plastic saucers that are twice or even three times the width of the pot, and which have sides 30-40mm in height. Watering then becomes easy. Just fill the saucers, once or twice a week depending on weather conditions. I am assuming here that aesthetics is not an issue ... we are growing veggies for home use.



ALL veggies require full sun conditions. You could place the pots out in the open, or on a verandah that faces north to north-east ... so that they get the benefit of full sunlight for as long as possible.

Some suggested pot sizes for a few different vegetables.

Knol Khol, Bush Beans (single plant), Parsley (single plant) – 140mm pot.

Chilies, most types – 200mm. (The very tall 'Kochi miris' is better in a 300mm pot). Bush Beans (three plants), Capsicum – 200mm pot.

Tomato, Brinjal (... or Egg Plant, Aubergine), Karapincha (Curry Leaf tree), Bitter gourd, Maekeral (Long Bean), Runner beans – 300mm pot. Don't forget that for the last three you will also need a frame of sorts for them to climb on. The tomato will need support.

Mukunuwenna, Kungkung, Gotukola, Parsley (six to eight in the box) – styrofoam boxes. Why have I added parsley? ... because it makes a 'bloody good' mallung, did you know that? When harvesting your crop in these boxes, cut the whole lot down about 30-40mm from the base, give them an application of fertilizer each time, and off you go again. Do not let them mature too much before you harvest them. There are two types of gotukola ... a creeping type and a clumping type. Treat them both the same way.

I need some guidance from readers of this Newsletter. WHAT would you like me to write on, if anything? Maybe readers would just like to ask me some horticultural questions, or inquire about problems they have with their plants!! We could confine this section to 'questions and answers' if you like. What do you think? There would be more interaction, and possibly more interest, that way!
