





From the Kitchen.....

Sri Lankan Beef Smore

Ingredients

½ ts Fenugreek 250 ml Coconut Milk, thin Curry leaf sprigs 675 g Beef 4 Cardamom 25 ml Vinegar 1 ts Chillie powder 2 ts Paprika ½ Lemon grass stem 25 g Coriander 3 Garlic cloves 4 Clove 250 ml Coconut milk, thick 25 g Onion 1/2 ts Fennel 125 ml Oil 25 g Ginger 2 Tomatoes

2 cg Cinnamon stick 25 g Curry Powder

Preparation

Wash the meat and prick it all over with a skewer or fork. Chop the onion, garlic, ginger and tomatoes. Crush the cloves and cardamoms. Place the meat in a pan and pour the thin coconut milk over the top of it. Add the onion, garlic, ginger, tomato, cloves, cardamom, cinnamon stick, curry powder, fenugreek, lemon grass, fennel powder, coriander powder, chillie powder, paprika powder and vinegar. Mix spices into meat and milk and bring to the boil. Simmer gently until the meat is tender for approximately 1 hour. Pour in the thick Coconut milk, and cook for a further 15 minutes. Pour the gravy into a bowl. Add the oil to the pan and fry the meat until browned. Pour the gravy back into the pan, bring back to the boil, then discard the cinnamon stick. Remove the meat to a carving board, cut into slices and serve with the gravy.

Out of the world's top 10, Australia has 5).


I finally got around to going fishing this morning but after a while I ran out of worms.
