THE SHRINE OF OUR LADY OF GOOD HEALTH AT MADHU, SRI LANKA, IS BETTER KNOWN AS OUR LADY OF MADHU. IT HAS BEEN IN EXISTENCE SINCE 1670 AND IS CONSIDERED THE HOLIEST CATHOLIC SHRINE IN SRI LANKA. IT HAS BEEN A SYMBOL OF UNITY NOT ONLY AMONGST THE SINHALESE AND TAMILS BUT ALSO BETWEEN PEOPLES OF OTHER RELIGIONS.

THE SRI LANKAN CATHOLIC COMMUNITY IN AUSTRALIA UNITED TO BUILD A CHAPEL TO HONOUR OUR LADY OF MADHU AT THE SHRINE OF OUR LADY HELP OF CHRISTIANS AT MARIAN VALLEY, CANUNGRA.

THERE ARE MANY INTERNATIONAL CHAPELS AT THIS SITE, BUILT BY THE VARIOUS ETHNIC COMMUNITIES AROUND BRISBANE TO REPRESENT THEIR PARTICULAR DEVOTION. YEARLY CELEBRATIONS ARE OFTEN OBSERVED BY THESE COMMUNITIES, WHERE FELLOWSHIP AND COMMUNITY EVENTS TAKE PLACE. ONE OF THE MOST BEAUTIFUL AND INSPIRING ASPECTS OF MARIAN VALLEY ARE THE OUTDOOR LIFESIZE FIGURES DEPICTING THE STATIONS OF THE CROSS THAT MOVE YOU TO HUMILITY, DEVOTION AND PRAYER.
