IMPORTANT! PLEASE READ

Please note ruling about non-attendance at our Dances and Have-a-Chat parties.

RULE: Non-attendance at Events after tickets have been sold

- 1. 

50th Anniversary Celebration - POSTPONED

As you will know, the specially appointed 50th Anniversary Celebration Committee has spent the last two years planning activities to celebrate this important milestone for our Club, the main event being a Gala Dinner Dance with a band from either overseas or interstate. After a lot of tireless work, we booked a well known band from Melbourne and even booked their airline tickets and planned a great function at the Grand Chancellor, Spring Hill for June 2020.

The rest is history. Covid-19 forced us to cancel all these plans and start again. Based on the prevailing circumstances, what was available and ensuring we kept to our budget, we then booked the Mansfield Hotel's Function Room for 21st November. Then Covid's second wave hit Melbourne which meant that there was some uncertainties about the band. Once again, we re-doubled our efforts and found a local band to guarantee music for the night, and moved the function to the 5th December, the latest possible date to give us the best chance of the QLD Govt lifting their restrictions on 'dancing' and 'mingling' when in large groups.

However, the Committee feels that this uncertain environment is likely to remain, and does not give us a chance to plan and organise a Dance worthy of this special occasion. So, with great reluctance and deep regret, we took a decision to postpone the Dance until next year in the hope that we will have more certainty and normalcy, and can have the kind of event we always aspired to. Other options such as having a gala dinner in a City Hotel sometime this year were also considered but reluctantly, the Committee felt that the sensible decision is to wait until next year; hopefully, there may even be a vaccine!

I want to assure you that throughout our many meetings and discussions, we were always positive about wanting to have a function this year, but ultimately we had to face current realities. I seek your understanding that we tried our hardest and will continue to work relentlessly towards a truly memorable function at the first available opportunity.

In the meantime, we are planning two very special functions in October and December (see the Newsletter for more details) and we hope you will support them strongly. Your Committee remains committed to doing the best we can for you, our members, while maintaining a strong awareness of our responsibilities for keeping everyone safe in this Covid environment..






~The Beauty Of Friendship~


It was from the Have a Chat parties that the Club then progressed in having its ever popular Golden Years Party another regular feature on our calendar of events.


