

President's message

Greetings members,

The Club celebrated its 53rd Anniversary in June and it's always a good time to pause and reflect on the history of our beloved club, and the thousands of 'good times' had by our members over that time. It's also a time to acknowledge the contribution of so, so many members (and usually their families) who have given their time, skills and often their personal resources to help manage the Club over those years. We owe all of them a debt of gratitude for putting their hands up over the years to provide those 'good times' for their fellow members and guests.

I want to start this report by noting, with considerable sadness, the passing of two stalwarts of the club in June, my uncle Alie Gonsal (Camille's husband) and 'Donny' Henderling (Rena's husband and Jeremy's Dad). Alie was such a lovable larrikin who spent about 10 years on the Committee, and we all know the huge contribution made by the Henderling family to our Club over many, many years. I believe Alie and Camille were married for 59 years while Donny and Rena had a marriage of 67 years. They will be sadly missed, and never forgotten. Rest in Peace, Alie and Donny.

Our Anniversary function on 12th June attracted close to 70 members and guests. Interestingly it took a huge push and appeal from the Committee before we got a great crowd to the event. There was some feedback about costs which I will come back to later. The function itself went off very well. Our new caterer Ruwan from Negombo Caterers put on a really tasty (if a bit chillie hot!) buffet and Ty Fox played some timeless music. I want to especially thank Christina and Jerome for making the Anniversary/Christmas cake for everyone virtually at cost, probably less. They are always doing other little acts of kindness to help the Club and Committee and we greatly appreciate their support. More about the function in the separate report in this Newsletter.

In upcoming functions, you will find flyers for our 'BBQ and Bowls' event on Sunday 6th August and our Hollywood Dinner Dance on 23rd September in this Newsletter.

The BBQ and Bowls is something a little different for a change and will be from 2pm – 6pm. We want it to be a casual, fun afternoon of 'having a go' at a game or two of Bowls followed by a nice little BBQ cooked by the Committee members. Numbers are limited to 60 and cost is only \$20pp so please come along and join in the fun.

Our Hollywood Dinner Dance will be held at the Sip 'n Dine at Woolloongabba and we want everyone to dress up in their best threads and come dance the night away. As announced in my last Newsletter, Roger Menezes and his band Jetfire (featuring his good friends Gordon Rebeira and Darrell de Silva) are coming up from Sydney to provide some great music for the night. They are all well credentialed musicians having played for all the top bands in Sri Lanka in their time, and we are really excited to have them entertain us on the night. Please check out the details in the flyer in this Newsletter and book early.

I'd like to come back to the feedback we received regarding cost of tickets and again, in the interests of full visibility, give you some insights into the Committee's thinking and decision making in this regard. Actually, there are a few issues which the Committee is constantly challenged with, not just fees. The three main issues are:

Do we have day functions or night functions? Given our demographic, we have lots of members who say they can't/don't drive at night while others seem ok with it. So the Committee tries to have a balance. At this stage, there are three functions we have each year which are night functions, these being our Annual Dance, Christmas Party and NYE. We have also been under pressure to have the Christmas party as a day event but singing Carols in the middle of the day just doesn't feel like Christmas to us.

Do we have Sri Lankan Food or Western Food? Again, we face a conundrum because some members queried why they need to spend \$45 for the Anniversary Lunch when they can eat Rice and Curry at home, so they won't attend the function. Equally, when we have put on western food, we get grumblings that "we've always had Sri Lankan buffets" and why are we changing? The Committee has to make a call on this as best it can, as we have done for the Melbourne Cup Party we've planned for November; it'll be a Melbourne Cup type meal which won't be Sri Lankan. This means that some members won't support us, purely because it is not rice and curry.

Cost of tickets are too high (especially if you're giving us Rice and Curry)? With all due respect to our members, we can no longer run \$25 and \$30 functions. We also no longer haggle with caterers to squeeze every extra pappadam out of them. Costs of everything have gone up, but we do get competitive quotes before we make decisions. Caterers also need to add the costs of delivery, serving, clearing and washing up when they quote us; the committee can no longer do these things to save the Club a few dollars. But the main thing to note is that the Club has to cover about \$6,000 of fixed costs per year (for things like Newsletter Printing/Postage, Website, Insurance, Storage etc). This means that we can't just 'break even', we have to add a minimum of \$3-\$4 for each ticket to cover these fixed costs. I was also surprised to hear of a perception amongst some members that we get the venue and music free of charge. We do get the best rates we can, but neither is free.

Trust this clarifies the way we approach these challenges. I assure you that we take our financial responsibility very seriously and set prices accordingly. Please continue to support us and just come have a good time.

Before I finish, one of Colombo's premier bands, The Redeemers, are coming to Brisbane for a dinner dance on Saturday 29th July and the organisers have advertised in our Newsletter. The band comprises eight very talented musos and this is their first visit to Brisbane, and it should be a great night. Please note that the organisers have offered Silver Fawn members a \$5 discount on ticket prices.

That's about all for now. Keep well, stay safe and be kind to each other.
