6. No meals will be provided in the event that a member is unable to attend an event.

PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

We have enjoyed two functions this year, and I am delighted to say that both were successful and thoroughly enjoyable. One very important reason for that success has been the Chair of both subcommittees, Suzie Anthonisz. Her wonderful organisational skills, creativity, and attention to detail have made an enormous difference. I should know—she has been practising on me for 53 years!



The Mother's Day Afternoon Tea was a very special occasion and a great success. We had to cap numbers at 100 and still had a waiting list, which says a great deal about the enthusiasm of our members. The fashion parade, music from Ray Anthonisz and Johnny Cole, catering by Jeremy Henderling, the beautiful décor, and the "Dressing Up the Mother" competition all helped make the afternoon memorable. You will find more about this lovely event later in the newsletter.

The Baby Boomers Party Band, together with guest crooners from among our own members, kept the dance floor full and the atmosphere lively. The meal was enjoyable, and the unobtrusive alternate-drop menu added to the pleasure of the evening as members and guests gathered in their formal attire. Although we had 86 attendees and still had to meet the minimum booking of 100, it was a night out to remember.

While both events were successful, each brought its own challenges. Our 56-year history helps explain this. Many of our members prefer daytime events, particularly because night driving, city venues, parking, and cost can be difficult. Others enjoy the chance to dress up and attend an evening function, where cost may be less of a concern. There is probably a third group who enjoy both—and I know the Committee is always encouraged by that support. For the Gala Dance, much of the preparation was completed beforehand through meetings and phone calls, and the hotel staff managed the set-up and pack-down. By contrast, the Mother's Day Afternoon Tea required hands-on work from the Committee, with only two hours to set up before the event and about an hour and a half to pack down afterwards. Like many of our daytime attendees, we are also mindful of the practical challenges that can come with age and disability. I do not pretend to have a perfect answer. We simply need to keep listening, stay aware of the different needs within our membership, and plan our events with care. Read about the exciting upcoming events further in this newsletter.

I would also like to let you know that our Club is moving to a new bank, ANZ, as our long-standing bank no longer meets our needs. For the moment, you may use either bank for EFT payments while we complete the transfer to ANZ.

We are also moving to an online booking system. There is a fuller explanation of TryBooking, along with an opportunity to practise using it, later in the newsletter. Please do give it a try. You will still be able to book a function by phone and pay by EFT, so no one will be left behind. We hope the new system will make bookings clearer for everyone and help avoid the confusion that can occur when payments are made without a committee member being advised. Under the current system, we also sometimes have bookings that remain unpaid until we follow up, only to find that the people are no longer attending. By then, the Club may already have confirmed numbers with the caterer and can lose money as a result. We hope this change will make the process easier for all.

Change is always with us, and your Management Committee is doing its best to adapt while continuing to care for the needs of our members. Please remember that Committee members are volunteers who give their time and energy to help the Club continue to thrive. Throughout Silver Fawn's 56-year history, we have adjusted to many changes while keeping our members at the heart of what we do. With your patience, support, and goodwill, we will continue to do so. Thank you, as always, for your support and friendship.

BOOKING EVENTS ONLINE

A quick guide for Silver Fawn Club members

We are launching an online booking system (using TryBooking) in October for those members who wish to book and receive immediate confirmation. **For those who prefer to contact a committee member and pay by EFT you can still do so.**

Anyone who wishes to book online will be able to follow these simple steps:

1. Click the **EVENT LINK**: Event links will be in our newsletter, on our website or posted to our Facebook page.
2. Click the **BOOK NOW** button: Select the number of tickets you need.
3. Select your tickets: 'Financial Member' or 'Non-financial member'.
4. Enter Attendee Names: You need to provide the first and last name for each person attending, their email (or use your own if they don't have one). These are required for each ticket holder. Phone numbers are optional.
5. Dietary Requirements (optional): A place to list any special dietary needs.
6. Payment: You can pay online with a Credit Card, PayPal or EFT/Direct Debit (bank transfer).
7. Once complete, you will receive a payment receipt or an EFT invoice for payment (depending on your selected payment method). Once payment is received you will receive an email confirmation and your ticket/s.
8. All communication for the event will also arrive to your inbox.

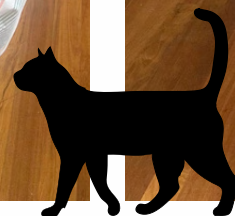

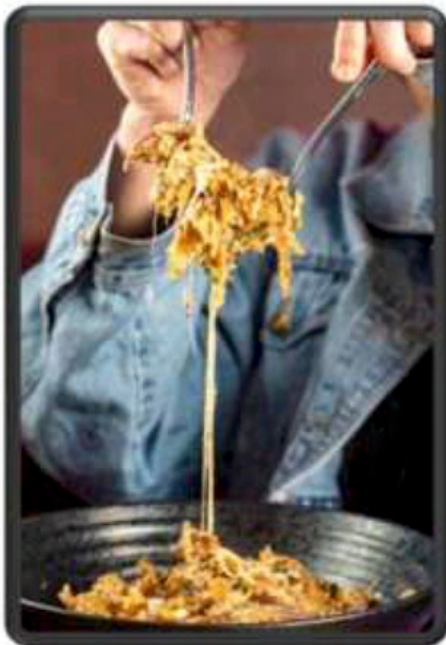

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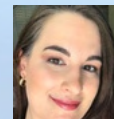
